OVERVIEW

Coquerel Family Wine Estates is located just beyond the town of Calistoga at the north end of the Napa Valley. The heart and soul of our winery is our Walnut Wash estate vineyard, a gorgeous, oak-studded property that sits in the afternoon shadows of the Mayacamas Mountains. Since 2005, we have done extensive enhancement and replanting of the site to ensure world-class fruit from vintage to vintage. The combination of warm temperatures and deep, clay soils make this ideal terroir for Sauvignon Blanc, our flagship variety. It also produces exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Verdelho, Tempranillo and Petite Sirah. In 2015, we planted 5 acres of estate Cabernet Sauvignon on clay soil (clone 169 and 4 on rootstock 3309) and Cabernet Franc (clone 214 on riparia) with narrow high density 3x5 spacing.

VINTAGE

Vintage 2025 was overall cooler and rainier than the previous year. In the vineyard, we left grass in every other row to maintain enough soil structure for tractor access. Despite the cooler temperatures, bud break occurred at the end of March, flowering at the end of May, and harvest began on August 25th, just as it did in the previous vintage. Our Le Petit Sauvignon Blanc was harvested August 25th.

WINEMAKING

The fruit for our 2025 Le Petit Sauvignon Blanc came from our estate Walnut Wash Vineyard in Calistoga. Once in the winery the clusters were de-stemmed and gently pressed to avoid any bitterness. The juice was fermented in stainless steel barrels and aged sur lie with frequent stirring to increase body and texture. Bottling took place in March 2026.

TASTING NOTES

The 2025 vintage opens with an expressive and powerful bouquet of pink grapefruit, fresh guava, and zesty lemon, accented by delicate floral notes of citrus blossom and star jasmine. On the palate, the wine is crisp and mouthwatering, featuring a silken, round mid-palate gained from frequent sur lie stirring in stainless steel. Layers of pineapple, passion fruit, and a hint of salinity lead into a long, refreshing finish that captures the perfect balance of Napa Valley intensity and French-inspired elegance.
