2025 ESTATE ROSÉ OF CABERNET

OVERVIEW

Coquerel Family Wine Estates is located just beyond the town of Calistoga at the north end of the Napa Valley. The heart and soul of our winery is our Walnut Wash estate vineyard, a gorgeous, oak-studded property that sits in the afternoon shadows of the Mayacamas Mountains. Since 2005, we have done extensive enhancement and replanting of the site to ensure world-class fruit from vintage to vintage. The combination of warm temperatures and deep, clay soils make this ideal terroir for Sauvignon Blanc, our flagship variety. It also produces exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Verdelho, Tempranillo and Petite Sirah. In 2015, we planted 5 acres of estate Cabernet Sauvignon on clay soil (clone 169 and 4 on rootstock 3309) and Cabernet Franc (clone 214 on riparia) with narrow high density 3x5 spacing.

VINTAGE

Vintage 2025 was overall cooler and rainier than the previous year. In the vineyard, we left grass in every other row to maintain enough soil structure for tractor access. Despite the cooler temperatures, bud break occurred at the end of March, flowering at the end of May, and harvest began on August 25th, just as it did in the previous vintage. Our Rose of Cabernet was harvested October 12th. The fruit was full of flavor with tasting notes of strawberry and ripe red fruits which we love in our Rose of Cabernet.

WINEMAKING

The fruit for our 2025 Rose of Cabernet came from our estate Walnut Wash Vineyard in Calistoga. Once in the winery the clusters were de-stemmed and gently pressed to avoid any bitterness. The juice was fermented in stainless steel barrels and aged sur lie with frequent stirring to increase body and texture. Bottling took place mid-March 2026.

TASTING NOTES

This 100% Rosé of Cabernet Sauvignon captures the vibrant energy of the Walnut Wash Vineyard with nice magenta color. On the nose, it opens with an elegant bouquet of wild mountain strawberry, Rainier cherry, and a hint of crushed rose petals. Because it was fermented entirely in stainless steel, the palate is exceptionally crisp and focused. Bright acidity drives flavors of tart pomegranate and ripe red fruit, leading into a clean, mineral-driven finish that reflects the unique volcanic soils of our Calistoga estate. It is a sophisticated expression of Rose, refreshing, dry, and beautifully balanced.
